Location: Early Learning Annex 111 Stedman # 100 in Ketchikan  
 The second session focuses on teaching strategies which help children learn friendship skills, including how to share, how to get along with others, and how to manage their emotions. The Teaching Pyramid is based on research which demonstrates that only a very small number of children (less than 4%) will need individualized, intensive intervention for challenging behavior if classrooms are built on nurturing relationships, supportive environments, and include responsive teaching strategies. ## TRAINING DESCRIPTIONS

### Planting the SEED of Success: Foundations of Early Care and Education Cohort Group

This is an overview of the field of early childhood and is an orientation to working with young children. Participants must register for the full series of trainings that will include follow-up self-study for a total of 32 hours of training in all eight CDA areas. This training is offered **FREE** of charge to licensed providers.
